Feast Days of the Week

Monday 13th At. Anthony died in Padua in 1231 at the age of thirty-six. Born in Portugal, he had joined the Franciscans and preached against heresy throughout France and Italy.

Tuesday 14th St. Davnet lived and died at Tydavnet at Sliabh Beagh, Co. Monaghan. Tradition speaks of St. Davnet as a founder of a church or monastery. A bachall (staff) said to have been hers has been preserved and in the past it was used as a test of truth.
