Feast Days of the Week

Monday 15th August Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, this feast honours the fullness of blessedness, body and soul, that was Mary's destiny in heaven where her virginal body was united to her immaculate soul.

Tuesday 16th August St Stephen of Hungary, 975-1038, patron saint of Hungary and its first king. Worked for the conversion of the Hungarian people.

Wednesday 17th August Our Lady of Knock commemorates the apparition in Knock, Co. Mayo in 1879 of Our Lady, St Joseph, St John the Evangelist with the Lamb on the altar. Friday 19th August St John Eudes, 1601-1680, French Oratorian priest who founded the Sisters of Our Lady of Charity and Refuge and promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart. Saturday 20th August St Bernard, 1090-1153, Cistercian monk who was chosen as abbot of Clairvaux. Venerated as a doctor of the Church because of this teaching on biblical studies, spiritual theology and philosophy. Patron of Gibraltar and beekeepers.
