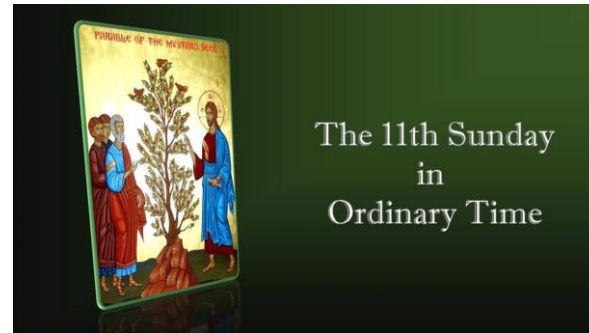

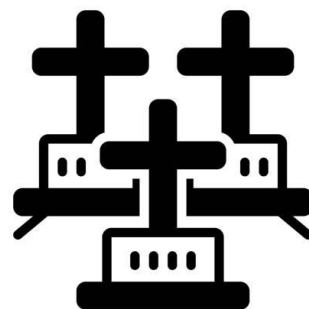
Mass at St. Michael's Cemetery, Blackrock
