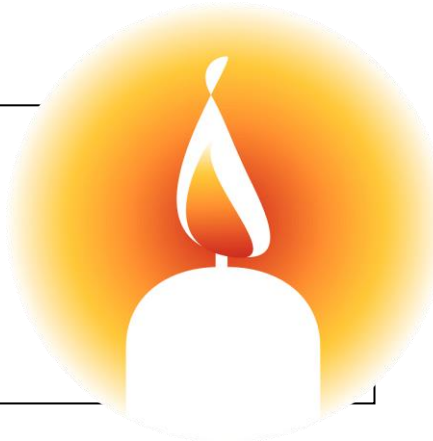
**Deaths**
