Feast Days of the Week.

Monday 23rd Padre Pio, died 23rd September 1968. Capuchin friar, stigmatist, confessor, friend of all who suffer.

<u>St. Eunan</u> was born in Donegal around 624 and died in 704. He became a monk in Iona and was chosen abbot there in 679. One of his writings is the Life of Colum Cille.

<u>Wednesday 25th St. Finbarr</u> came to Gougane Barra and lived there as a hermit. When disciples gathered round him, he moved to Cork at the mouth of the Lee where he founded a monastery which became a famous centre of learning.

<u>Thursday 26th Ss. Cosmas and Damian</u>, early martyrs in Syria, patrons of physicians.

<u>Friday 27th St. Vincent de Paul</u>, 1580-1660, committed to care of the disadvantaged and oppressed, founded the Vincentians and the Daughters of Charity, the first sisters to work outside their convents in active service. He is the patron of all charitable works.
