# Feast Days of the Week.

#### Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September St. Jerome

Translated the Bible into Latin and wrote commentaries on scripture. Patron of librarians.

#### **Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> October St. Thérèse of Lisieux**

Marie François Thérèse Martin died in Lisieux on 30<sup>th</sup> September 1897. She was declared a doctor of the Church by Pope John Paul II in 1997. Patron of missions, florists, aviators and France.

#### Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October Bl. Columba Marmion

Joseph, his baptismal name, was born in Dublin in 1858 and ordained priest in Rome in 1881. He served as curate in Dundrum Parish and then as professor in Holy Cross College, Clonliffe, before entering the Abbey of Maredsous, Belgium. Elected as abbot in 1909. He died in 1923. His trilogy, Christ the Life of the Soul, Christ in His Mysteries and Christ, the Ideal of the *Monk*, has been some of the most influential spiritual writings of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, nourishing the lives of generations of seminarians, priests, religious sisters and monks. He was beatified in Rome on 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2000.

# Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October St. Francis of Assisi

Abandoned all things for the love of Christ, founded the Friars Minor, and with St. Clare, the Poor Clares. For the last two years of his life, he suffered the stigmata. Patron saint of ecologists.
