Feast Days of the Week.

Monday 9th St. Ciaran was born in Roscommon around 512. He came to Clonmacnois in January 545 where he founded a monastery which was to become one of the most renowned in Europe. He died at the age of thirtythree while the monastery was still being build. Tuesday 10th St. Peter Claver born in Catalonia in 1580, a member of the society of Jesuits.

Thursday 12th St. Ailbe is sometimes claimed as one of the pre-Patrician saints, but the annals note his death in 528. A tradition held that he went to Rome and was ordained bishop by the pope. He founded the monastery of Emly which became important in Munster. A ninth-century Rule bears his name.


Friday 13th St. John Chrysostom, 347-407, one of the four great Greek Doctors. He incurred much opposition and died in exile. Patron saint of preachers.
